We have had contractors look at the situation and give us advice and estimates for dealing with this problem. The board will look at the most cost-efficient solutions. A board member brought up "door to door" solicitations. Our property manager, Dick Krebs, suggested accepting pamphlets from unwanted solicitors, and then calling their company to complain. (Phone number should be on pamphlets.)
